Start Me Up

Former PPEist Clare Harrison is the founder of <u>Start Me Up</u>, an entrepreneurial education programme. Headquartered on the tropical island of Bali, Start Me Up focuses on cultivating indemand skills via startup work experience placements and training.

Hundreds of people from over 15 countries have taken part in the program, attracting students and alumni from some of the world's top universities (Princeton, Cambridge, Oxford, Cornell, Northwestern). Alumni have gone on to launch their own businesses and work for the likes of Google, Amazon and McKinsey.

Clare will share her experience of transitioning from a media career in London to international entrepreneurship in Asia-Pacific.

BabaBoom Kebabs

Eve graduated from Keble with a PPE degree and is the founder and owner of <u>BabaBoom</u> – a growing casual dining restaurant chain focused on fresh Middle Eastern cuisine.

After a stint at McKinsey, and with support and investment from the Nando's CEO & the Gumtree's founder, BabaBoom launched on Battersea Rise in 2016. Fast forward to 2019 and BabaBoom has served over 200,000 kebabs, expanded to a second site, created 40 jobs and been covered in the Telegraph, the Evening Standard and on the BBC.

Eve will share her story on how working in an earthquake devastated Haiti kick started her kebab shaped dream, why BabaBoom hires Ex-offenders and how Brexit hasn't deterred her from kicking off her latest fundraising round.
